## **SPECIAL RULES**

This show will be conducted in full accordance with the official show and contest rules of the American Quarter Horse Association as per the latest edition of the rules and amendments adopted by AQHA. Only AQHA registered horses are eligible to show in the AQHA approved classes.

**No small motorized vehicles except golf carts allowed on fairgrounds and ALL vehicles, including golf carts must be operated by a licensed driver.**

1. **INTERPRETATION OF RULES:** The right to settle all questions or disputes incident to the Quarter Horse Show is reserved by the Dixie National Manager, or their designated representative. All exhibitors or other participants, as a condition of admission, consent to such method and agree to be bound thereby.

2. **ANIMAL HEALTH REQUIREMENTS:** *The Dixie National Quarter Horse Show* requires that all horses (including those from Mississippi) brought on the show ground, must be accompanied by a Negative Equine Infectious Anemia Test Certificate (**ORIGINAL COPY OF CERTIFICATE, PHOTOCOPIES WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED**), bearing lab number, with animal identification, issued within twelve months prior to show date, plus a current health certificate (**ORIGINAL COPY OF CERTIFICATE, PHOTOCOPIES WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED**) issued within thirty days. Certificates will be checked at the live-stock gate (Gate 14). No canine animals will be allowed inside buildings on the fairgrounds.

3. **Entry closing date:** All entries must be postmarked on or before **January 16, 2012**. Late entries will be accepted by payment of \$25.00 late fee per horse plus all regular class fees. Late entries must be made **NO LATER THAN 5:00 p.m. prior to** the day of the class to be entered. Official working orders will be posted by 7:30 p.m. daily.

4. **Entry Forms:** The entry forms MUST contain all information requested, including complete mailing address of exhibitors and owners. Incomplete entry forms WILL NOT be processed (this includes assigning stalls). For info contact: Pat Kress, 8704 Aragon Ln; Knoxville, TN 37923-5801. Phone, (865) 690-9902. Fax, (866) 605-2518.

**All entry forms must include:**

A. Complete entry form **with Agent Signature & Owner Social Security Number and address**. No entries will be accepted by telephone, but completed entry forms may be e-mailed or faxed using credit card payment. (Visa/Master Card).

B. Full payment of entry fees and stall fees (if stall is requested). If stall is not requested, **fee MUST include ground fee of \$5.00 for each horse.**

C. Copy of both sides of registration papers on all horses entered. Youth and Amateur must show original papers at show if papers are old type certificate which lists owner on the back.

D. **Contestants in AQHA classes must be members of AQHA or AQHYA.** Amateur entries must hold valid AQHA Amateur Card. **Copy of AQHA membership card for exhibitor must accompany entry.** If necessary, AQHYA, AQHA and AQHA Amateur memberships may be purchased at show office.

E. On youth and amateur entries, the horse must be owned by the exhibitor or a member of his or her immediate family. If the horse is not owned by the exhibitor, please state relationship of exhibitor to owner. **The Dixie National WILL NOT accept permits from amateurs or youth to exhibit horses not meeting AQHA ownership requirements.**

F. **NRHA:** All horses competing in NRHA approved competition will be required to have a competition license. The competition license must be purchased **PRIOR** to the show. Please contact NRHA for this. **To enter NRHA approved competition, the competition license, rider's membership card as well as the membership card of owners listed on competition license must be current and copies MUST be included with your entry forms.** Memberships can now be purchased at the show if you are riding in a non-pro class.

Your membership card must also say "Non-Pro." If it does not, you may complete a non-pro declaration at the show.

G. **NSBA:** Membership numbers of exhibitors and owners are required with Entry.

H. **Social Security Number of payee. Premiums will be paid to owner.** Checks will not be released until office has **Address and Social Security Number of Horse Owner.**

I. **Exhibitor confirmations will be mailed to Stall Agent address on Entry Form. Stalls and Packets will be filed under Stall Agent in Show Office.**

J. Any change in exhibitors must be cleared with office or entry will be disqualified.

**Shavings Office:** Will be accessible twenty-four hours a day. Pre-Bedding will NOT be available. *Shavings office Managed by the Mississippi Fair Commission.*

**NOTE:** ***Shavings MUST BE PAID before they will be delivered. NO EXCEPTIONS!***  
***Shavings are \$7.00 per bag.***

**ABSOLUTELY NO WRITING ON THE STALLS. INFORMATION MAY BE HUNG ON STALL FRONTS.**

5. **WORKING ORDERS:** Working Orders will be posted by 7:30 p.m. the night before, after late entries have been entered. Exhibitors must ride in cuts as drawn. \*\* The Working Order for Class #29 will be posted by 7:30 p.m. on Tuesday, February 15<sup>th</sup>.

6. **CONFLICTS IN SCHEDULING:** With two arenas operating, there could be an entry conflict. **It is the obligation of the exhibitor to notify the show office of an entry conflict PRIOR to the start of the class, so the order can be adjusted.**

7. **PATTERNS:** Pattern books will be available for purchase in the show office, and will be posted by 7:30 p.m. daily.

8. **PRACTICE RIDING SCHEDULE:** Schedule for the Coliseum, Equine Center, and multi-purpose building will be posted. The use of lounge lines will not be allowed in Show Arenas during scheduled practice riding.

9. **TRAILERS:** Trailers with or without horses will be allowed to ***leave through gate #14 only.***

10. **NO REFUNDS:** In the event an entry must cancel due to lameness or injury, the entry may be substituted by the same owner, provided the show secretary is furnished with a veterinarians' written statement **PRIOR to the time the class is called.**

11. **PREMIUM PAYMENTS:** All monies will be paid to horse owner. Prize money will be paid on composite placings. All monies will be calculated based on the number of horses shown in the class, except where rules state otherwise. Checks will be mailed by March 31, 2012 and should be cashed within ninety days. **No claims will be honored by the Dixie National's after June 10 of the year in which the premiums are won. Premiums will be paid to owner. Social Security Number and address of Owner MUST be on Entry Form!**

12. **POINTS:** For the 2012 Dixie National Show, AQHA has allowed us to have 4 AQHA Shows running simultaneously. Each of the four (4) judge’s placings will produce separate results. **Therefore, FOUR (4) full sets of AQHA points will be awarded.**

13. **FEES AND PAY BACKS:** Only one total entry fee is charged: One entry fee enters the contestant in all four shows. The contestant does not have the option of entering only one show. The Pay Back (PB) is the portion of the Total Entry Fee that is paid back in Winnings in addition to the Added Money. The Fee presented includes ALL Fees due. This Fee and Pay Back Schedule is Standard unless otherwise noted for a Class.

14. **AWARDS & MONEY PAID ON COMPOSITE PLACINGS:** Ribbons will be awarded under each judge (1<sup>st</sup> – 10<sup>th</sup>). In all classes the money, awards and prize winners will be determined based on composite placings of all four Judges, and the composite winner will be “Dixie National Champion.” **EXCEPTION:** In timed events and roping, money will be awarded on time. In Cutting, Working Cowhorse and Reining, composite winner will be based on combined Judges scores. In case of ties, money will be divided with one judge pre-designated as tie-breaker for awards. Working order for Class #29 will be posted at 7:30 p.m., Tuesday, February 14<sup>th</sup>, 2012.

15. **BACK NUMBERS:** AQHA rules state “It is mandatory that exhibitors wear visible entry numbers. Failure to do so will result in disqualification.”

16. **AMATEUR ALL AROUND AWARD:** An Amateur All Around **Trophy Saddle**, sponsored by *Harris Leather & Silver Works*, will be awarded to the winner of the most composite Amateur points in the show. A Reserve Plaque will be awarded to second place. Only points earned in Amateur Classes will count. **NO SELECT AMATEUR POINTS** will count toward this Award. *To qualify you must show in at least 3 categories, and rules of the AQHA will be followed to determine the winners.*

17. **YOUTH ALL-AROUND AWARD:** A Youth All-Around Saddle, sponsored by *Harris Leather & Silver Works*, will be awarded to the overall youth with the most composite points in the show. *To qualify you must show in at least 3 categories, and rules of the AQHA will be followed to determine the winners.*

The **Andree’ Hopkins Memorial Trophy** will be awarded to the overall composite high point youth of the show. An award for Youth 14-18 and Youth 13 & Under will be presented in each age category to the winner of the most youth composite points in the show, with reserve awarded to second place. *To qualify you must show in at least 3 categories, and rules of the AQHA will be followed to determine the winners.*

18. **ENGLISH ALL-AROUND AWARD:** An English All-Around will be awarded to the high point horse in the open English classes in the show. (Must show in 3 English classes with Pleasure Driving counting as an eligible class.)

19. **NOVICE YOUTH & NOVICE AMATEUR HI-POINT AWARD:** A Novice Youth Hi-Point Award will be presented to the winner of the most composite Novice Youth points in the show. A Novice Amateur Hi-Point Award will be presented to the winner of the most composite Novice Amateur points in the show.

20. **MOTOR HOMES:** MQHA does not take reservations for motor home hook-ups. For information on motor home hook-ups, contact the Coliseum office: Coliseum, P.O. Box 892, Jackson, MS 39205. (601) 961-4000.

21. **PARKING:** Exhibitors will be asked to park in designated areas.

**Vehicles in FIRE LANES or NO PARKING areas WILL BE TOWED!**

22. **NO TIE UPS:** Horses can only be tied to horse trailers. DO NOT tie up to MFC property (i.e. fences, panels, poles or gates)

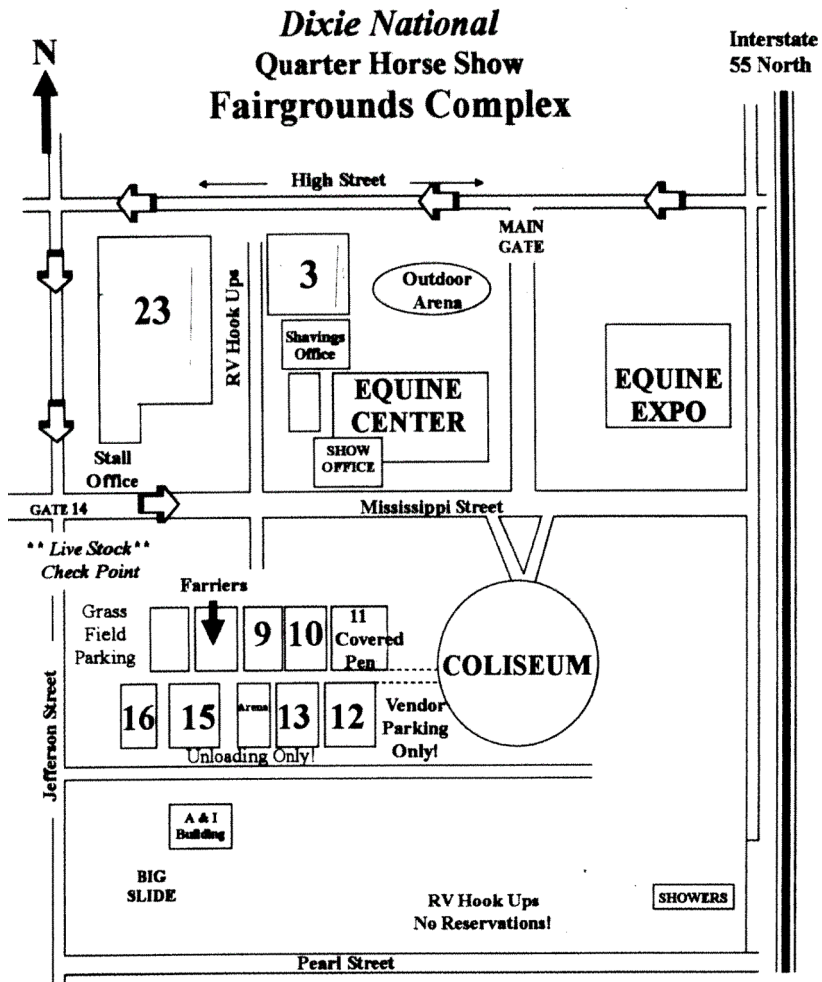
