Guidelines for the MQHA Scholarship Fund

Excerpt from Resolution of the Board of Directors Establishing an MQHA Scholarship Fund

- D. Determination of Recipient(s) of Scholarship:
3. No recipient shall be a relative of any of the Committee members within the second degree according to Mississippi Law, either by blood or marriage. (son, daughter, niece, or nephew)
- E.
1. Must be an active member of the MQHYA for at least two (2) years prior to filing the application or, in case of a current college student, said student must have been an active member of the MQHYA for at least (2) two years prior to reaching his/her nineteenth (19th) birthday. Said active participation for two (2) years does not have to be consecutive. Each of the two (2) years of active membership in the MQHYA, said applicant must have shown and/or exhibited in a minimum of five (5) MQHA approved show days.
 2. Currently must be an active member in the MQHYA or in the event said applicant is enrolled in college, said applicant must be in good standing of the MQHA.
 3. Must not have reached his/her twenty-first (21st) birthday at the time of application deadline.
 4. Must be a resident of the State of Mississippi during qualifying period.
 5. Must be planning to attend a Mississippi college or university the following school year, regardless of his/her planned major.
 6. Must make application for each year of college on a yearly basis.
 7. Application must be received by the Scholarship Chair (see application for mailing address) no later than **Midnight, March 19, 2008**.
